called to tell me we were awarded the job of hosting their litigation on our system. The client asked that I check first to make sure I did not have a conflict of interest before committing to the project. I put them on hold, counted to 10, and then came back to the phone to tell them there wasn't a conflict, that we were good to go."

Cherished mementos: "I framed my first dollar earned and I still have my very first computer server. It was 'high tech' — containing three 9GB drives and a 200 MHz processor, it cost \$18,000 and is the size of a small car. With the advances in technology over the past 11 years, my cellphone has more processor speed and my digital

camera has more storage capacity."
